Free Medication Drop off coming to West Salem April 28th – 10am-2pm

The West Salem Police Department is joining forces with Coulee Council on Addiction and the D.E.A. to offer West Salem's 1st ever medication drop off.

You could be a drug dealer without even knowing it. With pill abuse at record levels, addicts are looking in as many medicine cabinets as possible – maybe even yours. As well, American teenagers are abusing prescription medication at record levels. They are often getting these dangerous drugs from family and friends. On **Saturday, April 28th 2012 from 10am-2pm**, DEA and its partners nationwide will operate collection sites in your community where Americans can turn in their unused, unneeded, and expired prescription and over-the-counter medications – no questions asked. This is a **free, anonymous service** that will help keep your home safe and could save lives.

One drop-off site in April will be located in the CESA #4 parking lot. CESA #4 is located at 923 E. Garland St., across the street from the Lakeview Health Center. No need to get out of your car, the drop-off is set up in a drive through fashion just follow the signs and the cones. Any names left on medications will be blackened out and no connection back to you will be made. Volunteers will be collecting dangerous expired, unused, and unwanted over-the-counter and prescription medication for destruction at sites nationwide.
